STATUTE
FOR THE 20th ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL
SHOOTING COMPETITION

Disciplines:

- 1. Polish Defence Holding - Centerfire Rifle** -The competitor fires 12 shots from a distance of 200 m at a 300 m rifle target (the 10 best hits are scored), prone position, time 3 minutes
- 2. Cenzin - HK416 full auto centerfire rifle** -The competitor fires 15 shots with full-auto from a distance of 300 m at a 90x90 target (the 10 best hits are scored), prone position, time 3 minutes
- 3. KBK AK 7.62x39 centerfire rifle** –the competitor fires 12 shots from a distance of 100m at the TS-4 target (the 10 best hits are scored), prone position, time 3 minutes.
- 4. Caliber - Glock Gen 6 Centerfire Pistol** -The competitor fires 12 shots from a distance of 25m at a special TS-10 target ("Frenchman"): three shots to the upper left circle + three shots to the upper right circle + 6 shots to the silhouette. The following are scored: 3 shots in the upper left circle + 3 shots in the upper right circle + the best 4 shots in the silhouette. Standing position, time 3 minutes.
- 5. Cenzin - HK SFP Match 9x19 Centerfire Pistol** -the competitor fires 12 shots from a distance of 25m at the "TS-cov19" target (the 10 best hits are scored, a maximum of one in each outer circle, and/or hits in the inner circles), standing position (both hands are allowed), time 3 minutes.
- 6. Kaliber - Centerfire Revolver** -the competitor fires 12 shots from a distance of 25 m at a TS-4 target with a white center (the 10 best hits are scored), standing position (both hands are allowed), time 3 minutes.
- 7. Cenzin - PCC HK MP5 Centerfire Rifle** –The competitor fires 4 series of 3 shots from a distance of 50m at a special target (terrorist), with the 10 best hits being scored. Standing position, time 3 minutes. Iron sights are used.
- 8. Cenzin - Mossberg smoothbore shotgun** -the competitor fires 11 shots from a distance of 50 m at a special target (5 circles), 3 shots at the middle circle and two shots at each of the other circles (the 10 best hits, maximum two in each circle, are scored), standing position, time 3 minutes.
- 9. Rimfire Pistol** –the competitor fires 12 shots from a distance of 25 m at the TS-4 target (the 10 best misses are scored), standing position, **weapon held with one hand**, time 3 minutes. Iron sights.
- 10. Tippmann Arms rimfire rifle**– the competitor fires 12 shots from a distance of 25m at a special target (American - 10 figures): 3 shots at the largest and 1 shot at each of the remaining targets (the 10 best hits, maximum one at each target, are scored: dot - 10 points, circle - 5 points, figure - 3 points), standing position, time 3 minutes. Iron sights.
- 11. Grenade throw** –The competitor throws a grenade from a distance of: 10m to metal targets – 1 point, 15m (to a special target) – 3 points, 20m (to a special target) – 5 points, or from a distance of 30m (to a figure) – 7 points for a hit. The competitor chooses the target. The competitor makes 1 trial throw and 5 scoring throws, time: 2 minutes. **The competition is included in the team classification only.**

ORGANIZATIONAL MATTERS

- Competition evaluation in accordance with PZSS and ISSF regulations
- Protests regarding the number of bullet holes in the target should be reported to the judge during the competition or immediately after the competition, before leaving the stand and approaching the targets.
- Protests regarding the calculations can only be submitted online using the provided form. A €50 deposit is required upon acceptance of the protest.
- Calibrated bullet holes are not subject to protests.
- **The organizer reserves the right to cancel the results of any discipline and not include it in the competition results if it cannot be held under uniform conditions for all participants, or if it is impossible for technical reasons beyond the organizer's control. The decision rests solely with the organizer.**
- The competition is open to people who have the ability to use firearms.
- **The Organizer does not provide participants with any life insurance: health insurance, civil liability insurance in the event of illness, accident, injury, death, or damage that may occur in connection with the participant's presence or participation in the competition, and does not bear any liability in this respect.**
- Telescopes are provided by the organizer - you can use your own
- The competitor must be equipped with hearing and eye protection.
- Medical coverage of competitions in accordance with applicable regulations.
- Alcohol consumption is prohibited during the competition. Individuals visibly under the influence of alcohol or psychotropic substances will be removed from the training ground and disqualified from all classifications.
- Participants are obliged to obey safety rules and instructions and commands of the shooting range operators and competition staff – under penalty of disqualification.
- A competitor who is disqualified for any reason specified in the regulations is not entitled to a refund of the entry fee.
- The competition takes place on an active training ground - it is strictly forbidden to stay outside the places provided and indicated by the organizer, especially moving around the training ground in your own vehicles.
- Parking of vehicles only in the place designated by the organizer.
- Military or sports clothing allowed.
- **The competition will take place regardless of the weather. The exceptions are weather phenomena that may pose a threat to the health or life of participants and staff. Cancellation or interruption of the competition for any of the above reason does not constitute grounds for a refund of the entry fee.**
- **The organizer is not responsible for items left or lost on the day of the competition.**
- The organizer DOES NOT PROVIDE protection against weather phenomena (rain, heat)
- Players are responsible for their own hotel accommodation.
- Competitors travel at their own expense.
- **The organizer has no right to appeal against the decisions of the training ground duty services regarding their decisions and applicable regulations (e.g. a ban on entry to the training ground of certain brands of vehicles).**

- **Weapons and ammunition are provided by the organizer. Moving around the training grounds with your own weapons is strictly prohibited, under penalty of disqualification.**
- **The use of your own ammunition is strictly prohibited, under penalty of disqualification.**
- **There is a total ban on manipulating sights at shooting positions, under penalty of disqualification of the entire team in the general classification.**

ORGANIZATIONAL MATTERS

- The start of the competition, preceded by the ceremonial playing of the national anthem and raising of the national flag, will take place on 30 May 2026 at 7:15 a.m. at the shooting range of the 1st Armoured Brigade in Warsaw-Rembertów.
- The planned closing ceremony and awards ceremony will take place at approximately 8:00 PM at the Rembertów shooting range. The time is subject to change.

The entry fee includes:

- **The Participant declares that the Organizer is not and will not be obliged to pay any fees related to the promotional activities described in the information on the processing of personal data below.**

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

The SALWA Riflemen's Association with its registered office in Wolomin, at 4 Korsaka Street, NIP 125-10-53-738, REGON 016246444, entered into the National Court Register under number **0000169116**, as the controller of personal data, informs persons applying for participation in competitions about the legal and formal requirements regarding personal data:

- **Personal data provided in the registration form may be transferred to the appropriate services for verification purposes.**
- Providing personal data in the application form is voluntary, but necessary for admission to the competition, due to the location and safety regulations.
- Refusal to provide personal data or refusal to consent to their processing for the purposes of organizing the competition will result in the inability to participate in the competition.
- Every person completing the application form or providing their personal data in the registration process has the right to access their data and to rectify it, delete it, limit its processing, the right to transfer data, the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing.
- The data provided will be processed on the basis of the currently applicable legal provisions and in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation only for the purposes of the professions for which they were provided
- Personal data will be stored for the period necessary to complete activities related to participation in the competition and published in the form of a final announcement on a publicly available website www.salwa.pl, and submitted in electronic form to the Polish Sports Shooting Association, in accordance with the requirements and regulations of the Association
- **Each person taking part in the competition has the right to request the anonymisation or removal of his or her personal data from messages published on the public website. www.salwa.pl, and transmitted in electronic form to the Polish Sports Shooting Association**
- Each person taking part in the competition has the right to lodge a complaint with GIODO if they believe that the processing of their personal data violates the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016.
- The Organizer reserves the right to send competition participants information regarding the competition and other events organized or co-organized by the Organizer, as well as for internal administrative and analytical purposes, via electronic communication, in accordance with applicable regulations.
- The Organizer reserves the right for itself and its associated entities to conduct interviews with each Participant, take photos and/or film, use names and surnames, images, voices and other

materials originating from or related to participation in the competition for advertising and promotional purposes, as well as the possibility of using them on the Internet or in radio and television broadcasts and for any other commercial purposes with the right to modify them in accordance with applicable regulations.
